National Policy on Climate Change Adaptation

2007 : Norwegian Climate Adaptation Programme

2008-2010 : Norwegian Report on Climate Change Adaptation

2013 : White Paper on National Adaptation Strategy

- Headed by the Ministry of the Environment
- 10 ministries
- Programme secretariat
- The Cities of the Future pilot project in 13 cities
- Continuous research, i.a. NORKLIMA, NORADAPT, KLIMAFORSK



Major Statements From the White Paper

- Extreme weather events
- Higher risk of landslides and flooding
- Different risks and new areas
- Infrastructure in urban areas vulnerable to intense precipitation and sea level rise
- Impact on species
- Major consequences in the Arctic region
- Direct impacts on the primary industries
- Pressure on the electricity infrastructure


